

Selection Criteria

SN	Selection Stage	Maximum Marks
1.	Marks based on %age in qualifying degree Aggregate %age in required base qualification divided by 5 (rounded upto 1 decimal point) For example: A candidate has completed his B.Tech with 65.72% and M. Tech. with 69.38%. Then the marks awarded would be as under: Required base qualification: B.Tech. (%age: 65.72) Marks awarded = $65.72 / 5 = 13.1$.	20
2.	Marks based on additional relevant qualification(s): For each additional relevant qualification (degree/diploma/certificate of more than 6 months), over and above the required base qualification, 5 marks would be awarded subject to maximum of 10 marks	10
3.	Marks based on additional relevant experience: For each completed year of additional relevant experience (over and above the required relevant experience), 1 mark would be awarded subject to a maximum of 10 marks	10
4.	Marks based on relevant experience in Government of Punjab: For each completed year of relevant experience in any organization of Government of Punjab, 1 mark would be awarded subject to a maximum of 5 marks	5
5.	Marks based on relevant experience in Government: For each completed year of relevant experience in any organization of Centre / State Government, 1 mark would be awarded subject to a maximum of 5 marks	5
6.	Scrutiny by Internal Committee	20
7.	Scrutiny by External Committee	30
