6. Important instructions for candidates:-

- a. Only eligible candidates will be called to participate in the selection process Annexure-A. Intimation in this regard will be given via emails. A notice in this regard will also be uploaded on the website: https://dit.punjab.gov.in/. The applicants may, therefore, go through all the terms and conditions carefully before applying for the post. The onus of checking the website regularly shall be on the applicant.
- b. Applications without the proof of deposit of fee (non-refundable) and / or not reflecting in the PSeGS account are liable to be rejected summarily without any intimation. Incomplete/ineligible applications are also liable for rejection without intimation.
- c. For determining candidature, eligibility and selection criteria, the decision of the PSeGS shall be binding and mere application does not entitle a candidate the right to participate in the final selection process.
